

## PROPOSAL

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, P.O. Box 5196, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809 until **2:00 p.m. on April 13, 2010** and will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter for the following:

This Invitation for Bid (IFB) is being released by the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, hereinafter referred to as the "Authority," to obtain bids for **Ozone System Improvements** at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant, 2061 Hospital Road, Wall Township, Monmouth County, New Jersey.

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary to remove and replace the existing ozone generators, ozone diffusion system, and ozone destruct system. The new ozone generators will be a liquid oxygen supplied system, replacing the existing air supplied system. A close-looped cooling system will replace the existing open-loop cooling system. The Contractor will be required to upgrade the ozone instrumentation and controls and facilitate the ability to measure ozone residuals upon leaving the contactors. The work also includes, but is not necessarily limited to installation of concrete pads and liquid oxygen tanks, construction of an aluminum catwalk system, and installation of new stainless steel piping, and pumps.

#### **A Mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on March 16, 2010 starting at 10:00 a.m.**

The meeting will assemble at the Manasquan Water Treatment Plant, 2061 Hospital Road, Wall Township, NJ. Directions may be obtained by accessing [www.njwsa.org](http://www.njwsa.org) and following directions to the Manasquan Administration Building located in the same complex. Failure to attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Site Meeting will be cause for rejection of any bid submitted.

All bids submitted shall be accompanied by a bid security amounting to not less than ten (10%) percent of the total bid price or \$20,000 whichever is less. Such security shall be in the form of a certified check or bid bond, payable or firmly bound to the New Jersey Water Supply Authority. Any bond submitted shall be posted by a recognized surety company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey and listed in Department Circular 570, 2009 Revision, of the U.S. Department of the Treasury, incorporated herein by reference. A certified copy of the agent's authority to act must accompany all bid bonds signed by an agent.

Bidding documents may be examined and/or obtained at the office of the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, P.O. Box 5196, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809 **on or after February 25, 2010** between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. or by calling (908) 638-6121, extension 300. **There is a fee of \$100.00 for each set of bidding documents requested, payable by check only.** The Authority will not be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any other source.

Any Contract awarded under this Invitation for Bids will be funded in part or in whole by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Environmental Trust, nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is or will be a party to this Contract, any lower tier Contract or Subcontract. This Contract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9 and 10. The successful bidder must comply with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.1 et seq. for the participation of small business enterprises owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDs). A goal of ten (10%) percent SED participation has been established for this project.

Restrictions on Political Contributions- bidders are advised that the Authority shall not contract with a business entity that has (I) solicited or made any Chapter 51 Contributions within a prohibition period or (II) failed to disclose all Chapter 271 contributions.
