Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, P.O. Box 5196, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809 until **2:00 p.m. on September 16, 2010** and will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter for the following:

This Invitation for Bid (IFB) is being released by the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, hereinafter referred to as the "Authority," to obtain bids for construction of a Water Quality Monitoring Station located on the Delaware and Raritan Canal at Landing Lane in the City of New Brunswick, Middlesex County, New Jersey. Some of the "major work items" required by the bidding documents include construction of a Water Quality Monitoring Station, Canal intake works and electrical works. Work includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Site clearing
- Protection of existing historical features
- Installation of temporary on-stream barrier(s)
- Construction of Canal outlet/inlet line
- Construction of concrete foundations and concrete masonry unit reinforced building
- Construction of interior and exterior finishes
- Construction of electrical works
- Removal and disposal of excavated material
- All necessary backfill
- Removal of on-stream barriers site restoration

All bids submitted shall be accompanied by a bid security amounting to not less than ten (10%) percent of the total bid price or \$20,000 whichever is less. Such security shall be in the form of a certified check or bid bond, payable or firmly bound to the New Jersey Water Supply Authority. Any bond submitted shall be posted by a recognized surety company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey. A certified copy of the agent's authority to act must accompany all bid bonds signed by an agent.

The Authority will not be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any other source.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, Chapter 127 and the Authority's subcontracting target programs and procedures.

Restrictions on Political Contributions- bidders are advised that the Authority shall not contract with a business entity that has (I) solicited or made any Chapter 51 Contributions within a prohibition period or (II) failed to disclose all Chapter 271 contributions.
