NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the New Jersey Water Supply Authority (the “Authority”) has applied to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Municipal Finance and Construction Element and the New Jersey Water Bank for a loan to grout the Round Valley Reservoir’s North and South Dam embankment abutments and dredge along an 800-foot long in-water channel leading to the South Tower Intake in the Round Valley Reservoir.

Proposed Project cost: \$3,700,000.

Proposed Project loan: \$3,700,000.

The Authority will make available for public review both the Environmental Information Document (EID) and the Department’s Environmental Decision Document (EDD) upon written request.
