

PROPOSAL

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, P.O. Box 5196, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809 **until 10:00 AM, on February 12, 2019** and will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter for the following:

WSA B19007
Round Valley Reservoir Structures Refurbishment and
Resource Preservation Project
North and South Dam Abutment Grouting
Hunterdon County, New Jersey

The Contractor will be required to furnish all labor, materials and equipment required for the drilling through soil and rock to install a grout curtain in both abutments each at South Dam and North Dam. The general scope of work for this project includes:

- Grouting at four locations.
- Following all permit conditions, including obtaining a Hunterdon County Road Opening Permit.
- Preparing a suite of stable high mobility grout mixes, sonic drilling, water pressure testing rock, pressure grouting rock, monitoring grouting activities, and preparing records of grouting activities.
- Project includes milling and paving a county road as well as site restoration of disturbed areas.

The Contractor will be required to Substantially Complete all work within 225 calendar days from Notice to Proceed, and offer for Final Acceptance the entire project within 245 calendar days from Notice to Proceed.

Only pre-qualified grouting firms capable of performing the type of work involved, either by their firm or as part of a joint venture, will be eligible to submit a bid. Instructions for pre-qualification are available at www.njwsa.org/procurement. Applications for pre-qualification will be accepted through January 29, 2019. Bid documents, plans and specifications will be provided to prequalified firms only.

A Mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at Spruce Run Administration Building, 1851 Highway 31, Clinton, NJ 08809 at 10:00 AM on January 17, 2019. Failure to attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Site Meeting shall be cause for rejection of any bid submitted. **PRESENTATION STARTS AT 10:15 AM – YOU MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE AT THAT TIME.**

All bids submitted shall be accompanied by a bid security amounting to not less than ten (10%) percent of the total bid price or \$20,000, whichever is less. Such security shall be in the form of a certified check or bid bond, payable or firmly bound to the New Jersey Water Supply Authority. Any bond submitted shall be posted by a recognized surety company licensed to do business in the State of New Jersey and listed in Department Circular 570, 2009 Revision, of the U.S. Department of the Treasury, incorporated herein by reference. A certified copy of the agent's authority to act must accompany all bid bonds signed by an agent.

This Contract or Subcontract is expected to be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank, nor any of their departments, divisions, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this Contract or Subcontract, or any lower tier Contract or Subcontract.

A goal of not less than 10% shall be established for the award of contracts to small business enterprises and controlled by one or more socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDs) in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 58:11B-26, N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.17(a)24 and 4.17(a)24, the Contractor (Subcontractor) shall comply with all of the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.

Bidders are required to comply with the provisions of the Division of Revenue Business Registration Certification Act (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44), Equal Employment Opportunity Compliance Requirements (N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 and N.J.A.C. 17:27), and the Diane B. Allen Equal Pay Act (P.L. 2018 c. 9).

Restrictions on Political Contributions- bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 2005, c.51 and c.271 concerning disclosure of political contributions.
