

REHABILITATION OF THE SIX MILE RUN CULVERT IS SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE – PROJECT UPDATE 9/10/2024

BE ADVISED: The [New Jersey Water Supply Authority](#) is doing a rehabilitation of the Six Mile Run Culvert that carries the Six Mile Run under Canal Road and the multi-use trail (towpath) in the vicinity of the Blackwells Mills Causeway in Franklin Township. This project will address past repairs on the culvert and prevent future deterioration of the structure.

As of September 10, 2024, the project is substantially complete. The Contractor will be performing site restoration and clean up. There are no further anticipated towpath or Canal Road closures related to this project.
