The Principal Consultant must furnish for the Authority's review and written approval the above items prior to a subcontractor being allowed to begin work on a project. The receipt and review of the above by the Authority does not alleviate the Principal Consultant's responsibility to ensure subcontractors' compliance with the Contract requirements.

**Details of the Standard Professional Services Required Forms, Registrations and Certifications are as follows:**

**Ownership Disclosure Form**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A.52:25-24.2, in the event the Consultant is a corporation, partnership, or sole proprietorship, the bidder must complete and sign the attached Ownership Disclosure Form. A bidder's failure to submit the completed and signed form may result in the rejection of the proposal as non-responsive and preclude the award of the contract to said bidder. If any ownership change has occurred within the last six months, a new Ownership Disclosure Form must be completed, signed and submitted.

**Disclosure of Investigations and Other Actions Involving the Vendor Form**

The bidder must submit the attached Disclosure of Investigations and Actions Involving Bidder Form to provide a detailed description of any investigations, litigation, including administrative complaints or other administrative proceedings, involving any public sector clients during the past five (5) years, including the nature and status of the investigation and, for any litigations, the caption of the action, a brief description of the action, the date of inception, current status, and if applicable, disposition. A bidder's failure to submit the completed and signed form may result in the rejection of the proposal as non-responsive and preclude the award of a contract to said bidder.

**Source Disclosure Form**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-13.2, all contracts primarily for services awarded by the Authority shall be performed within the United States, except when the Authority certifies in writing a finding that a required service cannot be provided by a contractor or subcontractor within the United States and the certification is approved by the State Treasurer.

Pursuant to the statutory requirements, the intended awardee of a contract primarily for services with the State of New Jersey must disclose the location by country where services under the contract, including subcontracted services, will be performed. The Source Disclosure Certification form accompanies the subject RFP. Failure to submit Sourcing information when requested may preclude award of the contract to the bidder.

**Restrictions on Political Contributions - Public Law 2005, Ch 271**

Political Contribution Disclosure: the contractor is advised of its responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement on political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 (P.L. 2005, c. 271, 3 as amended) if in a calendar year the contractor receives one (1) or more contracts valued at \$50,000 or more. It is the contractor's responsibility to determine if filing is necessary. Failure to file can result in the imposition of penalties by ELEC. Additional information about this requirement is available from ELEC by calling 1 (888) 313-3532 or on the internet at <http://www.elec.state.nj.us/>.

**MacBride Principles Form**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-12.2, the bidder must utilize the attached MacBride Principles Certification Form to certify that it is in compliance with the MacBride principles of nondiscrimination in employment as set forth in N.J.S.A. 52:18A-89.5 and in conformance with the

United Kingdom's Fair Employment (Northern Ireland) Act of 1989, and permit independent monitoring of their compliance with those principles. A bidder's failure to submit the completed and signed form may result in the rejection of the proposal as non-responsive and preclude the award of a contract to said bidder.

### **Subcontractor Certification**

For a proposal that does NOT include the use of any subcontractors, the bidder is *automatically* certifying that: in the event the award is granted to bidder's firm and the bidder later determines at any time during the term of the Contract to engage subcontractors to provide certain goods and/or services, the bidder will submit the attached Subcontractor Utilization Plan Form, for approval in advance of any such engagement of subcontractors.

### **Non-Collusion Certification**

By submitting a proposal, the bidder certifies as follows:

- a. The price(s) and amount of its proposal have been arrived at independently and without consultation, communication or agreement with any other contractor, bidder or potential bidder.
- b. Neither the price(s) nor the amount of its proposal, and neither the approximate price(s) nor approximate amount of this proposal have been disclosed to any other firm or person who is a bidder or potential bidder, and they will not be disclosed before the proposal submission.
- c. No attempt has been made or will be made to induce any firm or person to refrain from bidding on this contract, or to submit a proposal higher than this proposal, or to submit any intentionally high or noncompetitive proposal or other form of complementary proposal.
- d. The proposal of the firm is made in good faith and not pursuant to any agreement or discussion with, or inducement from, any firm or person to submit a complementary or other noncompetitive proposal.

The bidder, its affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, and employees are not currently under investigation by any government agency and have not in the last four (4) years been convicted or found liable for any act prohibited by state or federal law in any jurisdiction involving conspiracy or collusion with respect to bidding on any public contract.

### **Notice of All Contractor Set-Off for State Tax Notice**

Pursuant to P.L. 1995, c. 159, effective January 1, 1996, and notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, whenever any taxpayer, partnership or S corporation under contract to provide goods or services or construction projects to the State of New Jersey or its agencies or instrumentalities, including the legislative and judicial branches of State government, is entitled to payment for those goods or services at the same time a taxpayer, partner or shareholder of that entity is indebted for any State tax, the Director of the Division of Taxation shall seek to set off so much of that payment as shall be necessary to satisfy the indebtedness. The amount set-off shall not allow for the deduction of any expense or other deductions which might be attributable to the taxpayer, partner, or shareholder subject to set-off under this Act.

The Director of the Division of Taxation shall give notice of the set-off to the taxpayer, partner or shareholder and provide an opportunity for a hearing within 30 days of such notice under the procedures for protests established under R.S. 54:49-18. No request for conference, protest, or subsequent appeal to the Tax Court from any protest shall stay the collection of the indebtedness.

Interest that may be payable by the State, pursuant to P.L. 1987, c. 184 (c. 52:32-32 et seq.) to the taxpayer shall be stayed.

### **Affirmative Action Form**

The bidder must submit a copy of the New Jersey Certificate of Employee Information Report, or a copy of Federal Letter of Approval verifying it is operating under a federally approved or sanctioned Affirmative Action program. Bidder(s) not in possession of either a New Jersey Certificate of Employee Information Report or a Federal Letter of Approval must complete and submit the [Affirmative Action Employee Information Report \(AA-302\)](#). A bidder's failure to submit the completed and signed form may result in the rejection of the proposal as non-responsive and preclude the award of a contract to said bidder.

### **Business Registration Certificate**

Pursuant to [N.J.S.A. 52:32-44\(b\)](#), a bidder and its named subcontractors must have a valid Business Registration Certificate ("BRC") issued by the Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services prior to the award of a contract. The bidder must utilize the attached Business Certification Form to certify that it is in compliance.

Any bidder, inclusive of any named subcontractors, who does not have a valid business registration at the time of the proposal submission opening or whose BRC was revoked prior to the submission of the proposal should proceed immediately to register its business or seek reinstatement of a revoked BRC. Bidders are cautioned that it may require a significant amount of time to secure the re-instatement of a revoked BRC. The process can require actions by both the Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services and the Division of Taxation. For this reason, a bidder's early attention to this requirement is highly recommended. The bidder and its named subcontractors may register with the Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services, obtain a copy of an existing BRC or obtain information necessary to seek re-instatement of a revoked BRC online at <http://www.state.nj.us/treasury/revenue/busregcert.shtml>.

A bidder receiving a contract award as a result of this procurement and any subcontractors named by that bidder will be required to maintain a valid business registration with the Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services for the duration of the executed contract, inclusive of any contract extensions.

### **Indemnification Certification**

The Consultant, during the performance of work under this Agreement, shall defend, indemnify and otherwise save harmless the Authority, its employees, representatives, officers, and agents from any and all claims or actions at law, for which the Authority shall not be reimbursed by the Consultant's insurance, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and court costs, resulting from the negligent or willful misconduct, including errors and omissions, of the Consultant's, its employees or agents, to exercise such care, skill and diligence as professionals ordinarily exercise under similar circumstances.

### **Diane B. Allen Equal Pay Act Certification**

The bidder by submitting a Proposal certifies that in the event of an award resulting from this procurement shall comply with the provisions of the Act.

On April 24, 2018 Governor Phil Murphy signed into law New Jersey's Diane B. Allen Equal Pay Act (P.L.2018, c.9). The law provides in pertinent part that as of July 1, 2018, any employer entering into a contract with the State of New Jersey or any Instrumentality of the State for "qualifying services" or "public works" must provide to the Department of Labor and Workforce Development – upon commencement of the contract - wage and demographic data for employees who are employed in connection with the contract for "public works" and for all employees relative to "qualifying services". The report must contain the gender, race, ethnicity, job category, compensation, and number of hours worked for each employee.

The Department of Labor and Workforce Development is required by the Act to retain these records, and to make the information available to the Division of Civil rights, and, upon request, to employees and their authorized representatives. Information regarding the Diane B. Allen Equal Pay Act and its requirements may be obtained from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (LWD) web site at: <https://nj.gov/labor/equalpay/equalpay.html>. Two forms, as required by the law, are to be completed by employers. The forms should be used to report the employee's wage and demographic data.

### **New Jersey Business Ethics Guide Certification**
