

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Hunterdon County Heron Glen Golf Course, 110 Highway 202 & 31, Ringoes, New Jersey 08551, has made application to the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, 1851 Route 31, Post Office Box 5196, Clinton, New Jersey 08809, for renewal of its uninterruptible water supply contract of .088 million gallons per day (MGD) of which .079 MGD is deemed consumptive. If approved, the contract would be for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2030.

The water would be withdrawn from four wells and one irrigation pond, through existing intakes located at the Heron Glen Golf Course in Raritan Township, Hunterdon County, and used for golf course irrigation and domestic supply purposes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:11-3.2, that a public hearing will be held on said application on FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., in the Conference Room, at the New Jersey Water Supply Authority Administration Building, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809, at which time all persons, corporations and civil divisions of the State may be heard for or against the granting of the application. This public hearing shall be held before a Hearing Officer of the New Jersey Water Supply Authority. The applicant and other interested parties may be represented by counsel, at their discretion.

Objections, if any, must be filed with the Authority in writing to either the address listed above or at [info@njwsa.org](mailto:info@njwsa.org) ON OR PRIOR TO FEBRUARY 21, 2020, and each objection must specify the grounds thereof. Such objections should be supported by sworn testimony at the hearing. A copy of any objection filed with the Authority should also be sent to the applicant. The application and any other pertinent data may be examined by any interested party at the Authority's Administration Building between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. weekdays.

The Hearing Officer may recommend approval or denial of the application at a regularly scheduled Authority Board meeting.
