NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Veolia Water New Jersey, 69 Devoe Pl, Hackensack, NJ 07601, has made application to the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, 1851 Route 31, Post Office Box 5196, Clinton, New Jersey 08809, for an uninterruptible water supply contract for an amount not to exceed .490 million gallons per day withdrawn from an existing intake on the Delaware & Raritan Canal in Lambertville, Hunterdon County, New Jersey, and used for domestic and fire protection purposes. The requested diversion is the same amount granted in the Applicant's current contract for uninterruptible supply. If approved the contract would be for the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2045.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that any public comments on the application must be filed with the Authority to either the address listed above or at info@njwsa.org **ON OR PRIOR TO JULY 28, 2025** and each comment or objection should specify the grounds thereof. A copy of any comment filed with the Authority should also be sent to the applicant. The application and any other pertinent data may be examined by any interested party at the Authority's Administration Building by appointment between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. weekdays.

ALSO, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that if requested in writing to the Authority at the address listed above or at info@njwsa.org, the Authority will hold a public hearing on said application before a Hearing Officer of the Authority, on **WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2025**, at 2:00 p.m. at which time all interested persons, corporations and civil divisions of the State may be heard for or against the granting of the application. The applicant and other interested parties may be represented by counsel, at their discretion. If no such hearing is requested, a cancellation notice will be issued.

The application will be considered for approval or denial at a regularly scheduled Authority Board meeting.
