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## EXHIBIT A – SAMPLE PURCHASE ORDER AGREEMENT

## SECTION I – QUOTATION INFORMATION

### A. Issuing Office

This Request for Quotations (RFQ) is issued by the New Jersey Water Supply Authority Procurement Office, which is the sole point of contact for the purpose of this solicitation. The terms “vendor”, “contractor” and “bidder” may be used interchangeably throughout this document. Likewise, the terms “bid” and “quotation” may be used interchangeably.

### B. Quotation Preparation

The Bidder shall follow the instructions contained in Section IV of this document in preparing and submitting its bid.

Written questions prior to the bid due date shall be submitted to Kyle Clonan, Senior Watershed Protection Specialist at [kclonan@njwsa.org](mailto:kclonan@njwsa.org), if necessary.

### C. Revisions to the Request for Quotations

In the event it becomes necessary to revise any part of this RFQ prior to receipt of the quotations, it will be done by issuance of an addendum no less than five (5) business days, in advance of the date required for submission of the quotations. ALL ADDENDA WILL BE POSTED TO THE AUTHORITY WEBSITE (<https://www.njwsa.org>). There are no designated dates for the release of addenda. It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to be knowledgeable of all addenda related to this procurement.

Each addendum will become an integral part of the quotation documents and part of any contract resulting from this bid.

### D. Bidders Proposal

In order to be considered for selection, the Contractor must submit a complete response to this RFQ in accordance with the format in Section IV. **Partial quotations will not be accepted.** The complete quotation package should be returned sealed in an envelope with the Bid Number and Title on the exterior. Quotations will be opened and recorded at the office of the Authority, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809 on the date specified on the Quotation Form, and the results will be posted on the Authority’s Procurement webpage shortly thereafter (<https://www.njwsa.org>).

### E. Non-Collusion Certification

All bidders must complete the Non-Collusion Affidavit (Section IV) evidencing the bid has been submitted in good faith.

F. Obligations of the Vendor

The Bidder is required to carefully examine the bid documents, plans, and specifications before submitting a bid. The submission of a bid is considered to be the Bidder's representation that the Bidder has made such an examination and understands the conditions to be encountered; the character, quality and quantities of work to be performed; the material(s) to be furnished; and the requirements of the specifications and bid form. The Authority will make no allowance or concession for a Bidder's failure to examine the bid documents, plans, and specifications before submitting a bid.

G. Interpretations and Addenda

All questions about the meaning or intent of the Request for Quotations shall be submitted to the Authority in writing. In order to receive adequate consideration, questions should be received by the Authority at least seven (7) business days prior to the date fixed for the opening of Quotations.

H. Protests Against Award

Any objection to the decision of the Authority must be submitted in writing to the Contracts Manager within five (5) business days after the due date for receipt of quotations. Any objection filed must set forth specific grounds for challenging the award.

I. New Jersey Business Registration Certification

Bidders will be required to comply with provisions of N.J.S.A. 52:32-44, "Procedures Relative to Registration of Certain Businesses." These provisions are set forth in Section II.

J. Nondiscrimination/Affirmative Action

Bidders shall agree to the N.J.S.A. 10:2-1, as supplemented by N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., and all Affirmative Action Regulations issued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. These provisions are set forth in Section II.

K. Diane B. Allen Equal Pay Act

On April 24, 2018 Governor Phil Murphy signed into law New Jersey's Diane B. Allen Equal Pay Act N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.14 (P.L. 2018 c.9). Bidders shall agree to the provisions as set forth in Section II.

L. Americans with Disabilities Act

Bidders are advised that the Vendor and the Owner do hereby agree that the provision of Title II of the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 (the "Act") (42 U.S.C. 12101 et. seq.), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities in all services, programs, and activities provided or made available by public entities, and the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, are made a part of this Agreement, as set forth in Section II.

M. Conflict of Interest Law

Each Bidder must comply with the New Jersey Conflict of Interest Law, N.J.S.A. 52:13D-12 through 27. If the low or successful Bidder is a member of the Legislature or is a State officer or State employee or if the Bidder is a business entity of which more than ten percent (10%) is owned or controlled by a member of the Legislature or State officer or State employee, approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on Ethical Standards or the State Ethics Commission, as the case may be, must be received by the Authority within ten (10) days of notice to the Bidder that its bid was the low or successful bid. Failure to comply with the above or any provision of the New Jersey Conflict of Interest Law will result in disqualification of the bid. The Bidder is to detail this information on the Ownership Disclosure Form (Section IV) hereof.

N. Restrictions on Political Contributions

Pay to Play Prohibitions: pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.13 et seq. (P.L. 2005, c. 51), and specifically, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.21, it shall be a breach of the terms of the contract for the business entity to:

- A. Make or solicit a contribution in violation of the statute;
- B. Knowingly conceal or misrepresent a contribution given or received;
- C. Make or solicit contributions through intermediaries for the purpose of concealing or misrepresenting the source of the contribution;
- D. Make or solicit any contribution on the condition or with the agreement that it will be contributed to a campaign committee or any candidate or holder of the public office of Governor or Lieutenant Governor, or to any State or county party committee;
- E. Engage or employ a lobbyist or consultant with the intent or understanding that such lobbyist or consultant would make or solicit any contribution, which if made or solicited by the business entity itself, would subject that entity to the restrictions of the Legislation;
- F. Fund contributions made by third parties, including consultants, attorneys, family members, and employees;
- G. Engage in any exchange of contributions to circumvent the intent of the Legislation; or
- H. Directly or indirectly through or by any other person or means, do any act which would subject that entity to the restrictions of the legislation.

Political Contribution Disclosure: the Vendor is advised of its responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement on political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 (P.L. 2005, c. 271, 3 as amended) if in a calendar year the Vendor receives one (1) or more contracts valued at \$50,000 or more. It is the Vendor's responsibility to determine if filing is necessary. Failure to file can result in the imposition of penalties by ELEC. Additional information about this requirement is available from ELEC by calling 1 (888) 313-3532 or on the internet at <http://www.elec.state.nj.us/>.

O. Subcontracting Requirements

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:32-17 et seq., N.J.A.C. 17:13-4 et seq. and Executive Order No. 71, the Authority suggests that the prime Vendor consider awarding twenty-five percent (25%) of this contract to New Jersey based, Division of Revenue-Small Business Enterprise Unit registered small

businesses. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:14-1.1 et seq. the Authority suggests that if a Vendor proposes to utilize a subcontractor(s), the Vendor must make a good faith effort to award a goal of 3 percent (3%) of the dollar value of its contract to eligible disabled veteran businesses. The provisions are set forth in Section II thereof.

If the Bidder intends to utilize subcontractor(s), the Subcontractor Utilization Plan (Section III, Paragraph F) must also be completed and submitted with the bid indicating the subcontractor(s) participating, the subcontractor(s) small business category, and the type and estimated value of the subcontract. Note that a Bidder's failure to satisfy the small business subcontracting targets or provide sufficient documentation of its good faith efforts to meet the targets with the bid or within ten (10) days upon request shall preclude award of a contract to the Bidder.

When awarded a contract with subcontractor, the vendor is responsible for entering and maintaining current payment and contract data for subcontractors at the direction of the New Jersey Office of Diversity and Inclusion within the Department of the Treasury.

**P. Tax Exemption**

With respect to goods sold and/or the performance of work in the State of New Jersey, the Bidder is directed to the New Jersey State Sales and Use Tax Act. The Authority is an exempt organization of the type described in subsection (a) of Section 9 of the Act, therefore, the Bidder shall not include in the bid price any amounts for New Jersey State Sales and Use taxes on the goods and/or services requested under this bid. A copy of the exemption certificate is available upon request.

**Q. Set-off for State Tax**

All Bidders are advised that pursuant to P.L. 1995, c. 159, effective January 1, 1996, and notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, whenever any taxpayer, partnership or S corporation under contract to provide goods or services or construction projects to the State of New Jersey or its agencies or instrumentalities, including the legislative and judicial branches of State government, is entitled to payment for those goods or services at the same time a taxpayer, partner or shareholder of that entity is indebted for any State tax, the Director of the Division of Taxation shall seek to set off so much of that payment as shall be necessary to satisfy the indebtedness. The amount set-off shall not allow for the deduction of any expense or other deductions which might be attributable to the taxpayer, partner, or shareholder subject to set-off under this Act.

The Director of the Division of Taxation shall give notice of the set-off to the taxpayer, partner or shareholder and provide an opportunity for a hearing within 30 days of such notice under the procedures for protests established under R.S. 54:49-18. No request for conference, protest, or subsequent appeal to the Tax Court from any protest shall stay the collection of the indebtedness. Interest that may be payable by the State, pursuant to P.L. 1987, c. 184 (c. 52:32-32 et seq.) to the taxpayer shall be stayed.

R. Insurance

The Authority requires the prime Vendor to comply with insurance requirements as set forth in Section II.

Certificate(s) of Insurance shall be submitted to the Authority within ten (10) days after the contract is presented to the Vendor for signature.

S. Safety Requirements

The New Jersey Water Supply Authority has determined that the worksite conditions of this project constitute a potential for serious injury if appropriate safety measures are not followed by all personnel involved. When working on the project, the successful Vendor will be required to comply with all OSHA and New Jersey Water Supply Authority safety requirements.

Prior to commencement of any work on this project the successful Vendor will be required to coordinate all relevant safety related matters with the New Jersey Water Supply Authority Safety Coordinator.

T. Security Requirements

Throughout the duration of the contract, contractors, their agents, subcontractors, and representatives must maintain security protocols established by the Authority while working in and around secured areas. Contractors will coordinate job site access on a daily basis with the Authority assigned project manager. Buildings; pumping stations, vaults, chambers, towers or fenced and gated areas that are normally locked, must not be left open and unattended.

The Vendor shall adequately secure and protect its tools, equipment, materials and supplies. The Authority assumes no liability for any damage, theft or negligent injury to Vendor's property.

U. The Worker and Community Right to Know

The provisions of N.J.S.A. 34:5A-1, et seq., require the labeling of all containers of hazardous substances are applicable to the contract. Therefore, all goods offered for purchase, or utilized by the Vendor(s) in the performance of services must be labeled in compliance with the provision of the Act.

V. Standards Prohibiting Conflicts of Interest

Bidders are advised that the following prohibitions on Vendor activities shall apply to all contracts made with the Authority, pursuant to Executive Order No. 189 (1988), as set forth in Section II.

## SECTION II – PURCHASE ORDER “AGREEMENT” INFORMATION

The Vendor to whom the award is made will be required to execute a Purchase Order Agreement (hereafter "Agreement"), which will include the following conditions. The successful Vendor will also be required to furnish the necessary Insurance within ten (10) days after the "Agreement" is presented for signature.

## SECTION III – SCOPE/TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

### Introduction

The Manasquan Reservoir, located in Howell Township, Monmouth County, is owned and operated by the New Jersey Water Supply Authority (NJWSA) as part of the Manasquan Water Supply System (MWSS). The reservoir is the primary source for one drinking water treatment plant and a secondary source for a second drinking water treatment plant. In addition to its water supply function, the Manasquan Reservoir and the surrounding land is parkland operated by the Monmouth County Park System.

In 2017, Authority staff confirmed the presence of the aquatic invasive plant hydrilla (*Hydrilla verticillata*), among other native and invasive submersed aquatic vegetation (SAV) growing in the Reservoir. The Authority views AIS infestation, especially that of hydrilla, as a threat to clean drinking water supply. Because of this, the NJWSA has initiated a pilot herbicide treatment program over the past several years.

For the 2026 growing season, the Authority is contracting for a 21-acre herbicide treatment utilizing the product Sonar H4C over four treatments, occurring monthly from early June through September. Sonar H4C uses fluridone as its active ingredient. The contract also calls for a one-time 5-acre treatment with Komeen Descend in late August or early September, with the active ingredient copper ethylenediamine.

NJWSA staff will evaluate the effectiveness of the fluridone and copper herbicide treatments, their retention, and the spread of these herbicides throughout the Reservoir through a comprehensive herbicide monitoring program. NJWSA therefore seeks to contract with a qualified laboratory for water sample analysis of fluridone and copper and sediment samples of copper. Sampling events and necessary lab analysis are anticipated to be distributed approximately twice a month from June through November. Overwintering (December, January) samples may be necessary depending upon the degradation rate of the fluridone. Sampling sites will be primarily surface water sites for fluridone and copper samples but also include finished drinking water and intermittent QA/QC samples (e.g. field equipment blanks). A small amount of sediment samples for copper are also requested.

### Scope of Work

NJWSA seeks to contract with a laboratory for surface water and finished water sample analysis, and sediment sample analysis, from approximately June 1, 2026, through January 30, 2027. The final sampling plan will be influenced by the actual dates of herbicide treatment.

### Specifications for Fluridone water samples Analysis:

- For purposes of this quote, a total of 170 fluridone samples are anticipated. The final sampling protocol will be dependent upon a combination of treatment dates and reservoir conditions, but it is anticipated that this project will have 13 fluridone sampling events with 10 to 13 samples per event. A field equipment blank sample will be taken every fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) sampling event.
- Each sample will be analyzed for total fluridone concentration using US EPA Method 525.3 with a laboratory reporting limit of 0.35 ppb or lower.

- Low-level detections are required. Samples will be from both surface water (reservoir / non-potable water) and treated, finished drinking water. The laboratory must have or develop a calibration curve ranging from 0.1 ug/L to 5 ug/L fluridone (or another NJWSA approved range, which they may submit with their bid).

Specifications for copper water samples analysis:

- For purposes of this quote, a total of 40 total copper water samples are anticipated.
- These 40 samples will be spread between 3-6 sampling events and be a mix of surface water, finished water, and equipment blank samples.
- All samples should be analyzed by ICP-MS analysis through EPA Method 200.8 with a minimum laboratory reporting limit of 10 ug/L or less.
- This analysis is only anticipated to be needed between August and October 2026.

Specifications for copper sediment samples analysis:

- For purposes of this quote, a total of 8 total copper sediment samples should be anticipated.
- Total pricing per sample should be provided for total or near-total metals digestion of sediment (dry weight basis), such as SW-846 Method 3051A, 3052, or equivalent strong acid digestion, followed by ICP-MS analysis through EPA method 200.8.
- Results should be reported in mg/kg on a dry-weight basis, and the pricing should include standard QA/QC elements run by the lab, such as method blanks, matrix spikes, duplicates and reporting limits.
- Reporting limit should be 1.5 mg/kg or lower.

General Specifications:

- The laboratory must have a current certification and maintain certification through the National Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (NELAC) and/or NJDEP OQA for USEPA Methods 200.8 and 525.3, or have developed similar, in-house assays based on these methods which the Authority will review before bid award.
- A results-only data package and a non-conformance summary report are required for each sampling event. A full data package is not required.
- Sample drop off:
  - If the laboratory is located within 30 road miles of the Manasquan Reservoir (311 Windler Rd., Howell, NJ 07731, NJWSA staff will drop the samples off at the laboratory after sampling has concluded for the day. It is expected the laboratory will accept samples until at least 2pm on the day of sampling.
  - For laboratories located outside of this range, they must either provide courier services to a meeting point within 30 road miles of the Reservoir or overnight shipping services for each event.

- Sampling events and necessary sample drop off/shipping services will be scheduled by NJWSA approximately 3-7 days in advance but may be weather dependent.
- The laboratory will provide bottles, bottle labels, and chain of custody forms. Bottles provided by the laboratory will include preservatives when appropriate.
- Seven (7) day turnaround times are requested, unless the laboratory standard turnaround time is shorter.
- External quality controls will be performed by the contract laboratory by using method blanks, spikes, duplicate samples, maintenance of holding times, and records of analytical equipment calibration. Copies of all laboratory QA/QC reports will be submitted to NJWSA for each sampling event. These reports will be reviewed by the NJWSA's QA/QC Officer and the Project Manager for possible errors and omissions. Any uncertainty relating to the laboratory data and/or QA report will immediately be presented to the laboratory manager for verification or, if necessary and possible, for reprocessing of the sample. All laboratory instruments and process blanks, control samples, calibrations, and duplicates will conform to the laboratory's NELAP or ELCP requirements for QC.
- Respondents agree that submission of a quote warrants acceptance of the above general terms and considerations and guaranteed pricing for the duration of the project.

#### Quotation Requirements

Bidders must provide fee proposal by completing the table on Quote Form Attachment A as follows:

For laboratory sample analysis (Line items 1, 2, and 3), bidders must delineate the unit cost per sample for each method. Bidders should include the laboratory reporting limit for each method. The laboratory must provide proof of certification by NJDEP OQA and/or NELAC in their bid response. If the laboratory does not have current certification for any of the requested methods, they must provide their SOP for their method and justification. NJWSA holds to right to reject any bid with an uncertified method who do not meet necessary specifications. Actual reimbursement will reflect the total number of samples analyzed by the laboratory.

Bidders should include any additional fees per sample (waste disposal fee, etc.) into the unit sample cost. Any additional per event fees should be included with the Shipping and Courier fees.

NJWSA staff seeks to have the option to either ship the samples or meet a courier from the lab after each event. Therefore, bidders must provide two separate price quotations regarding shipping: one quotation for shipping services per event (line 4) and one for courier services per event (line 5). Prices for shipping should incorporate the cost for pre-paid shipping labels for secure overnight, trackable shipping from a standard shipping service (UPS, Fedex, USPS, or other). The shipping price should also include standard shipping materials provided by the lab, such as ready-to-ship coolers. The Authority will be responsible for adding loose ice to the samples, packaging the materials in two layers of plastic bags to prevent leakage of ice, taping and securing the shipping container, and dropping it off at the selected shipping center. NJWSA staff will schedule either a courier sample pick up or shipping event with the laboratory at least 3-7 days before any sampling event. Actual reimbursement will reflect the method chosen and invoiced for each event. If either shipping or courier services are included standard (no cost)

by the laboratory, "\$0" should be entered for the respective line on the bid sheet. Pricing is requested for both line 4 (Shipping) and line 5 (Courier Service).

The table should be filled out for the assumptions detailed and a total cost for the project tallied as indicated. The bidder with the lowest responsive and responsible bid when totaling all 5-line items will be awarded the contract.

NJWSA reserves the right to not accept a bid if the analytical method or laboratory reporting limits do not meet the criteria of the project, if local (within 30 miles) drop-off nor courier service is available, or if a copy of laboratory certification is not provided with the quote.

## SECTION IV – QUOTATION FORMAT AND CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Each Bidder is to follow the instructions contained in this section for submission of its quotation. Any deviation from these procedures may be cause for rejection of the quotation.
